Camp Quest, where it's OK not to believe in a God, is for boys and girls:

- Campers, ages 8 to 17, and for
- Counselors in Training (CITs), ages 14-17.

The dates for Camp Quest Smoky Mountains are July 25-August 1, 2010 C.E.

This year we expect the demand to be great, so register early to avoid missing out. There will be swimming, hiking, campfires, singing, crafts, science workshops, games, and other fun camp things, all in a manner consistent with secular humanist principles. The two invisible unicorns, introduced in the first year's "challenges" to campers, will be at camp (some say), and there will again be a prize for anyone who can prove they aren't there.

The camp takes place again this year at the Great Smoky Mountain Institute at Tremont, near Townsend, Tennessee within the Great Smoky Mountain National Park. Campers will stay in clean, air-conditioned, bathroom-equipped dormitories, with dedicated adult counselors. Food is prepared by the licensed staff of the GSMIT facility. Sign up early before it's too late.

Cost this year is \$575 (\$525 for additional siblings).

If all fees are paid 9 weeks before check-in, the total fee is decreased by \$50 (\$525/475). \$100 non-refundable deposit is required with application.
